Current Admissions Criteria (Partial List)

- Top 12.5% of all California high school graduates guaranteed admission
- Complete UC required core classes by senior year
- SAT Reasoning (or ACT with Writing) and 2 SAT Subject Tests required
- Any and all applications may be reviewed at the discretion of the UC Admissions Panel

New Admissions Criteria

(Partial List)

- Top 10% of all California high school graduates guaranteed admission
- Complete 11 of the 15 UC required core courses by junior year (this must be met or automatically ineligible)
- SAT Reasoning (or ACT with Writing)
 No SAT Subject tests
- 2.5% of student applicants Entitled to Review (ETR) of application; at the discretion of UC Admissions Panel
